**Student information**

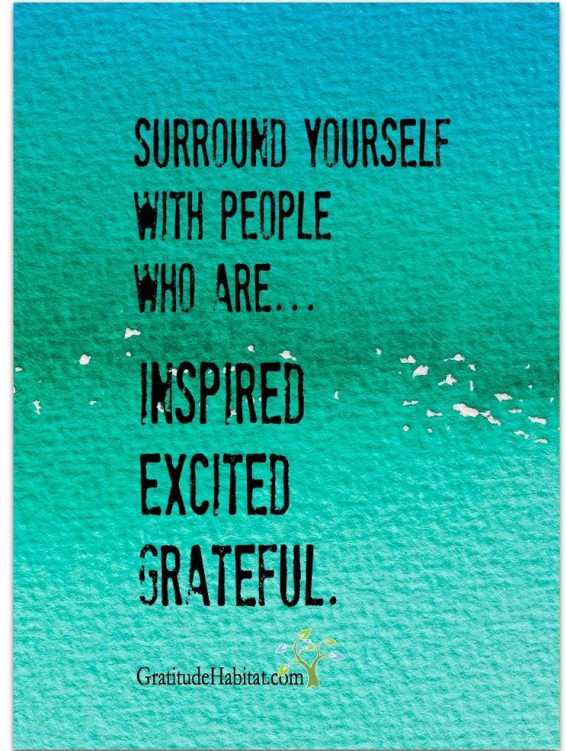
1. Halloween dress up rules: NO masks, faces must be visible, no weapons.
