Practice counting by 1's as high as you can. Write down the highest number you counted to!	Find something in your house that begins with each letter of the alphabet	Write uppercase and lowercase letters using your best handwriting	Draw a picture of your favorite season. Write a sentence to go with your picture.
Count forwards 1-20. Use small snack pieces, coins, marbles, or toys to practice counting each item once	Have someone read a book to you and draw a picture of your favorite part.	Write numbers 0-31 in order. OR Find numbers around your house and write them on a piece of paper.	Draw a picture of what the weather looks like today. Try to write a weather word that describes the weather in your picture (sunny, cloudy, snow)
Play Simon Says using different numbers and actions. For example, Simon says, tap your nose 10 times.	Write 4-6 sight words on a piece of paper. Hide the words around the house and ask your child to find and reach each one.	Write your first and last name 3 times each using 3 different colors.	Get a bowl of snow or ice cubes and time how long it takes to melt. Record the time.
Using your fingers, take turns with someone drawings shapes on each other's backs. Each time, guess the shape and try to find an example of that shape in your house	Write letters on pieces of paper and put them face-down on the floor. Turn a paper over and say the name of the letter that you see.	Draw a picture to show what you like most about being at home with your family. Write a sentence to go with your picture.	Test 5 objects in a cup of water to see if they float or sink
