

## Mrs. Kisler e-Learning Choice Board

- Student's choose 1 activity from each area they see Mrs. Kisler for during the school day.
- Mrs. Kisler's students can replace classroom options with these options, please return either the classroom teacher's board or this board with an adult signature to school.

Reading	Read to self for 20 minutes	See if you can find all the letters of the alphabet somewhere in your house.	Look at a book, how many sight words/heart words can you find?	Write 10 CVC (Consonant/vowel/consonant words, such as cat), read them outloud to someone	Have your adult write the letters of the alphabet. Practice your letter identification or letter sounds. Can you make any words with your letters?
Writing	Practice your letters in something; rice, sand, water, pudding, shaving cream, etc.	Draw a picture of what you are doing today	Write or stomp letters in the snow	Draw 3 different lines on a piece of paper, try zig zag, straight, curved. Then cut out the lines.	Write your letters uppercase or lowercase on a piece of paper.
Math	Write your numbers, start at 1 and go as far as you can go.	Make and count 20 snowballs. Can you count them forwards and backwards?	Have your adult write down 10 addition problems with numbers that equal 10 or less. (example: 2+6, 8+1), see if you can complete them all.	Practice skip counting, try by 2s, 5s, 10s, If those are easy, try 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, & 9. Challenge yourself!	Help make lunch, count how many items you needed to make it.
Social/ Emotional	Ask your grownup what you can do to help and then complete the task.	Clean up your room	Draw a picture of your favorite thing or place	Play a board game. Follow the rules and be a good sport, win or lose.	Think of 5 things you can do to help at your house today. How does this make you feel?
